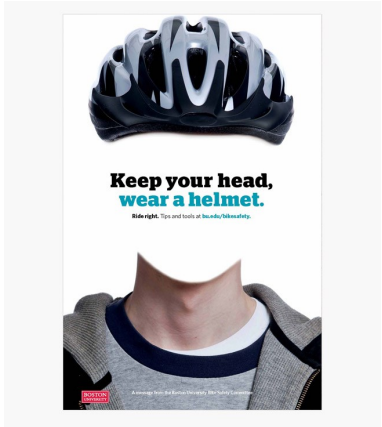


Wybers 'Big Days' in School
