Holidays during term time

Fixed penalty notices are issued (one per parent per child) if previous holidays have been taken or the child's attendance is below target.

Scooters and Bicycles on the Playground

For the safety of parents and children, please ensure that you and your children dismount and push cycles and scooters when on the school premises.



Travel Sickness Medication

If your child is on a trip and requires travel sickness medication, please give this to the teachers on the door rather than the office or letting children bring this to school independently. We can then ensure it is administered correctly.

SATs & Phonics Screening Checks
